

What does a reversal operation after a male sterilization cost in 2026, and are these costs reimbursed?

Reimbursement for a reversal operation after male sterilization differs from the standard reimbursements we receive from health insurers. Below, we explain how the financial process for a reversal operation after sterilization works.

Treatments that are medically necessary are eligible for reimbursement. These costs can be claimed from your health insurer, and, as you are already aware, we will cover any part that is not reimbursed. If a treatment is **not medically necessary**, the health insurer will not reimburse the costs. The procedure for a reversal operation after a male sterilization with declaration code 17E793 falls under non-insured care, which means we are unable to submit the invoice to the health insurer.

The cost of a reversal operation after male sterilization amounts to **€5.405**.

You are required to transfer the full amount to us prior to the operation in order for the procedure to be scheduled. After the treatment, you will receive an invoice from us. If you have supplemental health insurance you may attempt, separately from your payment to us, to submit this invoice to your health insurer. Please note that reimbursement is entirely dependent on the terms and conditions of your insurer. Unfortunately, we cannot guarantee that all costs will be fully reimbursed.

We therefore advise you to contact your health insurer in advance to avoid any unexpected expenses afterward. Please also take into account that we are not contracted with a number of health insurers, which may affect potential reimbursement even if you have supplemental insurance.
